INSTRUCTIONS: CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

In order to participate in the Southern California State Science Olympiad, your school is required to submit a Certificate of Insurance. This certificate of insurance clarifies that your district or insuring agency will provide liability coverage for each school's Science Olympiad participants, including staff and volunteers. Your team may not participate without a correctly completed and received certificate. If the certificate is not received before the registration deadline, your spot may be given to another school.

Insurance Certificate Language

Please provide this exact language information to the district or agency that will produce the Certificate of Liability Insurance or Evidence of Coverage Certificate.

Venue and Date:

The certificate must reference the correct venue (California Institute of Technology and Polytechnic School in Pasadena) and April 12, 2025.

Certificate Holder: Southern California Science Olympiad and their directors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers.

Additional Insured:

The California Institute of Technology, the Polytechnic School, the Southern California Science Olympiad, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers of each of them

Insurance Coverage

Please make sure the insurance covers at least \$2,000,000 per occurrence, and \$4,000,000 general aggregate.
